

## **Educ-Europe: research-action seminary in Poland...**



From May 18th to 22th of 2015, 32 participants from the eight partners of the new Educ-Europe project will meet again for the second and last research action session in

Bydgoszcz, Poland.

During the first meeting in Paris, from November 24th to 28th of 2014, two groups have been constituted in order to work on the “Development of the empowerment of educators and beneficiaries in the field of youth at risk and social exclusion”. These groups are characterized by their cultural and professional diversity (social workers, trainers, researchers and beneficiaries or former beneficiaries) that represent an asset for the training of social workers.

In Poland, the trainee-researchers will establish an assessment of the learnings and experimentations of their first research action. In addition, this inductive and reflexive approach will support the changing in the way of conceive social action and professional habits. It conveys the conviction that field workers, trainers and beneficiaries can look for the most fitted solutions together. Then, after this second session, the participants will write the research diaries in order to assess of the evolution of their reflections as well as their recommendations to ensure the dissemination of those results to a wide public.
